Sl. No.	Name of Course	Semester/Year	Description
1	Regional Development	3 rd Semester (2 nd Year)	The course includes Economic Development and Demographic study of North Eastern Region; Society and Culture of Manipur; History and Polity of Manipur and Manipuri Woman and the Changing World. These chapters are useful immensely in developing ethics, Gender and Human Values to the students.
2	Environmental Studies	4 th Semester (2 nd year)	The course includes a full paper of 100 marks completely devoted to environment related topics. This enables the students to be aware of the climate change and environmental issues. Chapters like Global warming, Ecosystem, Pollution, Biodiversity-hotspots, red list category etc. are included in this course.
3	Botany (Paper 202P)	1 st Semester (1 st Year)	It includes studies about viruses, bacteria and their roles in Environment and in maintaining sustainability.
4	Botany (Paper 303P)	3 rd Semester (2 nd Year)	It includes plant geography and distribution of plants.
5	Botany (Paper 610P)	6 th Semester (3 rd Year)	It includes plant breeding and sustainability.
6	Zoology (Paper 404 & 404P)	4 th Semester (3 rd year)	The course includes study of ecosystem, life history of economically important social insects like honey bee, silk worm and a fish. It also includes study of wild life animals and conservation strategies.
7	Anthropology (Paper 303)	3 rd Semester (2 nd year)	It includes Social and cultural anthropology and studies about relationship between culture, society and human being.
7	Anthropology (Paper 610P)	6 th Semester (3 rd year)	It includes Social and cultural anthropology and studies about relationship between culture, society and human being.
