A. The assessment will be carried out in 10 categories which consist of 1. Regularity of Teachers Attendance 2. Effective Teaching-learning process 3. Application of innovative teaching methods 4. Coordination of Teachers and Students 5. Examination and evaluation system 6. Translation of decisions taken in departmental meetings into action 7. Teachers' participation in career improvement programmes and research works 8. Computers and IT applications in teaching learning process and departmental activities 9. Office management and records keeping 10. Conduct of seminars/ workshop/ field visits etc. for experiential learning of students.

B. The MD will monitor the department whole academic year and give points from 0 to 5 (Low to High) according to the level of quality achieved in the criteria mentioned above. MD will give points at the end of every 3 months (i.e. February to April, May to July, August to October and November to January). CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average) will be calculated by dividing the total scores in the 10 criteria in the year divided by 2.
