Important Information to candidates

1. Incomplete application form shall be rejected summarily.
2. Original marksheet for the qualifying examination should be produced at the time of admission.
3. Admission fee once deposited in the college account shall not be refunded in any circumstances.
4. In case of any false information/omission detected in the varification of Certificates/Documents of a candidate After admission to a course, the college authority has the right to cancel such admissio at any stage.
5. In case of any controversy, the decision of the College Admission Committee shall be final.

1. Eligibility

A student who has passed 10+2 Examination of Council of Higher Secondary Education, Manipur or equivalent examination recognized by Manipur University is eligible for admission to B.A./B.Sc. Course. A student must complete the course within a continuous span of six semesters from initial admission.

Subjects available for honours courses are-

- (a) Arts Stream:
English, Economics, Political Science, History, Mathematics
- (b) Science Stream:
Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Mathematics, Anthropology, Economics
- (c) MIL : Manipuri, Hindi, Thadou Kuki, Nepali

Eligibility for Admission

Candidates seeking admission to the first semester of the Degree Course should have passed the Higher Secondary/an equivalent examination recognized by the Manipur University. The minimum P.C. Of aggregate marks of the qualifying Examination eligible for admission shall be decided by the College Admission Committee from time to time.

Admission Procedure

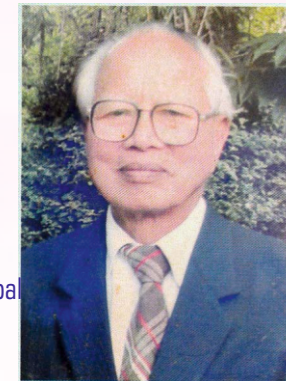
Prescribed application forms for admission along with prospectus can be had from the College Office. Students seeking admission to the undergraduate courses shall undergo online registration to the website of the Directorate of University & Higher Education, Manipur (www.registrationuhe.in) within stipulated time.

Admission Form and prospectus will be issued to the registered students counselling based on the data and documents submitted during registration will be done by the admission committee of the college. The admission committee will decide on whether admission test will be held or not for the particulars academic session. Final selected lists for admission to various programmes/courses opened in the college. Selected students will be allowed admission to the particular programme/course they have been selected for.

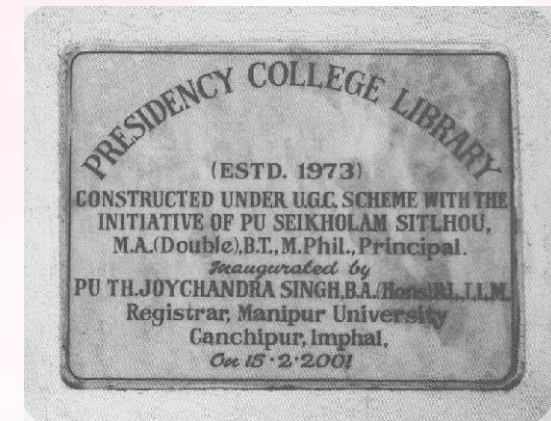
Enclosers to be submitted with the application form

UNDER GARDUATE COURSES:

There are two streams of under graduate courses namely Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Science under the ordinance of Manipur University Six-Semester system of undergraduate courses.

There shall be a six semester (three years) course of study leading to the award of the degree of Bachelor of Arts (Honours) and Bachelor of Science (Honours). Each semester shall consist of 90 (ninety) working days.
